



### ***Living with COVID update***

Since 01.04.22 updated Government guidance is now being disseminated for all schools and workplaces via Public Health Guidance.

#### Question:

**Should my child still go to their childcare or education setting if they test positive for Covid?**

#### Answer:

**No.**

From 1<sup>st</sup> April, anyone with a positive COVID-19 test result will be advised to try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for five days, which is when they are most infectious.

**For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be three days.**

**From April, healthy 5-11 year olds will also be offered the COVID-19 vaccine.** Vaccinations will take place outside of schools in vaccination centres, pharmacies, GPs and walk-in centres.
