

<p>Geography</p> <p>As Geographers, we will compare two locations using the internet. We will look at Naples and Aberdeen and compare landscape, tourism, mountains, and rivers. We will also use geographical data and create climate graphs. We will ask and respond to questions and offer opinions based on research. Using the data, we will analyse the data and draw conclusions. We will begin to make comparisons between the two locations.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>As mathematicians, we will study the decimal notation of money. We will use a variety of methods when looking at pounds and pence including the part-whole model. We will compare amounts using our place value knowledge. We will also explore estimating and rounding money to the nearest pound. We will learn how to add and subtract money. Then, we will apply our knowledge by solving a range of problems and reasoning questions related to money.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>As scientists, we will explore everyday phenomena and the relationships between living things and familiar environments. We will study a range of resources and the type of sounds they make, using scientific vocabulary to describe them. We will investigate how sound is produced and learn that vibrations are created when materials connect. We will record our findings and draw conclusions.</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>As swimmers, we will practice a variety of movement and strokes. We will begin to understand how our bodies react to water and practice breathing. We will use our arms and legs to practice strokes and develop muscular movement. We will begin to develop our balance as we roll and move in the water.</p>	<p>Learning in Year 4</p> <p>Term 5</p> <p>Music</p> <p>This term, the learning will be focused on one song: Lean on Me. Games, elements of music, singing and playing instruments are all linked in this unit.</p>	<p>Art</p> <p>Lathom Junior School will be entering 'The Big Draw' which takes place every year. The theme this year is 'Drawing the Senses' and we will be exploring a range of art techniques to explore the five senses and how these relate to us as artists. We will use our knowledge of basic Logo commands to read and write code. Then, we will create algorithms.</p>		<p>RE / PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE, we will be looking at 'Being me 'and thinking about what makes us healthy and what is good for us. We will think about our well-being and how we should deal with situations.</p> <p>In RE, we will explore what kind of things are special to our communities.
