As readers, we will be reading Holes by Louis Sachar. During our daily class reading sessions, we will continue to focus on our fluency and develop our comprehension skills. Also, we will discuss how the main character develops throughout the story and discuss the story plot. LOUIS SACHAR Holes	Money Wise This term, we will continue to explore the unit of work, Money Wise. These sessions will foster positive attitudes and decision making towards financial decision making. We will learn about making financial decisions and consider how to spend money including pocket money and contributions to charity. We will continue to use ipads to complete activities based on lessons.	Computing This term's unit is 3D modelling and we will develop our knowledge and understanding of using a computer to produce 3D models. Then, we will be working in a 3D space, including modifying and manipulating 3D objects. We will develop confidence using Tinkercad and introduced to place holders which can be used to create holes in objects. Finally, we will examine the need to group 3D objects, then go on to plan, develop, and evaluate their own 3D model.
PE This term, we will engage with orienteering activities. We will focus on problem solving as a team. The remaining lessons will be taught at school or through activities at the residential site. Our Sports Day will take place on Tuesday 13th June 2023 at Plashet Park. We will represent our teams demonstrating skills in agility, balance and coordination and earning points for our teams.	Learning in Year 6 Term 6	The topic for this term will be food technology and will correlate with Healthy Eating Week. We will explore a range of ways to eat healthier and will be designing, making and evaluating fruit and vegetable cakes, which will be presented to the rest of the school and parents as a 'Healthy Cafe'.
PSHE / RSE In PSHE / RSE, our topic will be 'Growing and Changing'. First, we will explore media manipulation and how to keep oneself safe online. We will identify positive strategies that could be used when dealing with challenging times of change. Then, we will explore the physical and emotional changes associated with puberty. All lessons are statutory except lesson 6 'making babies' – parents or carers will have the option to opt their children out of the lesson.	Production This term, we will continue our preparations for our upcoming leavers' school production, Peter Pan.	In RE, we will be exploring 'What qualities are important to present day religious leaders?' The 'Faith in Schools' workshop will take place in Week 1, when we will be introduced to the topic, Religious Leaders. We will discuss the roles and duties of religious leaders, including secular communities. In addition, we will apply ideas from religions and worldviews in a thoughtful manner.
