


<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Grammar and Punctuation</p> <p>During these sessions, we will revisit passive and active voice; advanced punctuation, formal and informal language; direct and reported speech and verb forms. Technology, Spelling Shed, LbQ and Spag.com, will be used to practise spelling, grammar and punctuation.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>As mathematicians, we will be studying geometry, in particular the key properties of shapes. We will measure and draw angles and then apply this knowledge when finding the angles of regular shapes. Then, we will solve missing angles in triangles, quadrilaterals, and regular polygons. Also, we will practise drawing triangles and quadrilaterals accurately based on given specifications.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths Boosters</p> <p>During Maths sessions, we will review concepts from the previous terms, specifically fluency. Reasoning sessions will include topics such as statistics, geometry, number, fractions, decimals and percentages.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Art</p> <p>As artists, we will be experimenting with the elements of art: line, colour, pattern, tone, shape and form; as well as looking at composition. In Summer 1, the whole school will be participating in 'The Big Draw'. This is a whole school art unit in which we will focus on one topic to create some amazing and inspirational art work. We will take ownership over our work by choosing our favourite piece to display in the Lathom Art Exhibition. This year, the subject is 'Drawing the Seasons'. We will participate in different art activities based around each season of the year, with a specific focus on the artist - William Turner.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Learning in Year 6</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Term 5</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>This term, we will develop skills required when playing cricket. First, we will practise throwing and catching techniques then move on to bowling and batting techniques. They will also learn how to become an effective fielder and how to strike a ball accurately.</p> <p>We will also explore the sport, badminton. We will practise catching and throwing a shuttlecock. They develop the skill of serving with their forehand and backhand. They will also learn how to play overhand and drop shots.</p>

We will practise answering a range of comprehension questions: retrieval, explain, inference, vocabulary, summarise and compare. During these sessions, children will be given opportunities to build fluency, gain deeper understanding of texts and also develop pace when answering test-style questions.</p>
