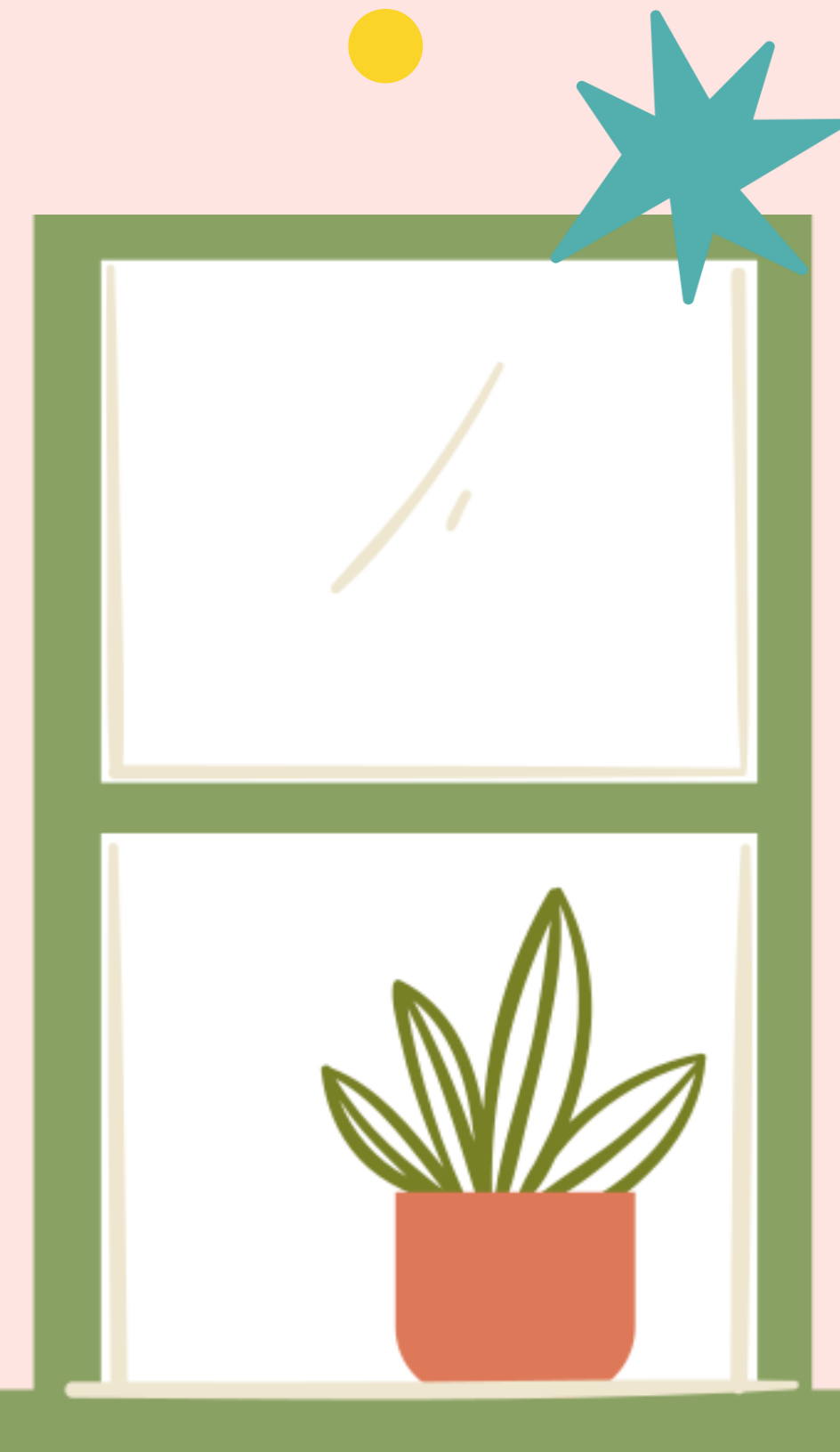

- To always respect school property and others around the school

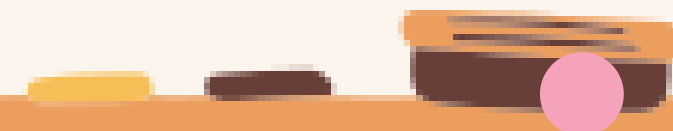




We follow a clear traffic light system that encourages children to model good conduct and behaviour.

- At the start of the day, each child begins on green.
- If a child misbehaves or breaks one of the classroom rules, they receive a verbal warning.
- If this is repeated again, the child is now moved down to amber. Should they repeat it, another verbal warning is given, reminding them of our values and their conduct.

If this is repeated again, then the child is now moved down to red. They will need to visit the reflection room at lunchtime, where a sheet is filled out with the learning mentors who will discuss their behaviour with them and provide support.
